Custom Likert Responses	Create custom responses for Likert questions by specifying your own desired number of choices and using your desired text.
Likert Tables	Save time by creating multiple Likert questions in a table format rather than having to create each question one by one.
New Conditions	Utilize two new conditions, known as IsPassed and IsNotPassed, to quickly see if a student passed a course.
Searchable Resource Manager	Save time by easily locating resources within your title by using the new search box within your resource manager.
Adjustable Image Compression	Decide how much or how little you'd like to compress images in a course when they are converted during publishing.
Automatic Unused Variable Removal	Easily clean up and maintain your title by automatically removing unused variables upon publish.
Cryptic Test File Names	Test files now have random, cryptic names to help prevent cheating.
Text Highlighter	Make it easy for students to find important text by using the new highlighter, which can include any color of your choice.
Adjustable Spacing and Line Height	Adjust line height within a text box and choose your own paragraph spacing.
Optional Text Formatting Marks	For easy editing, display text formatting marks such as paragraph returns, spaces, page breaks, and more.

My Documents Alias	Now you can easily identify the last titles you used by seeing the full names of your titles without having to scroll.
Display HTML Page Names	Conveniently view the HTML page names within your title at the top of each page properties window.
Resize Multiple Object Layouts	Quickly and easily resize multiple objects to the same width, height, or both. Enables you to easily align multiple objects.
Export Styles	Easily share text styles between authors or courses by importing and exporting desired styles.
Size Percentages	Make objects larger or smaller by specifying the percentage of the original size that you would like to use.
Reestablish Object Order	When selecting an object during editing, the object is brought to the top level so users can easily see and manipulate it. After editing, the object automatically goes back to the level it was originally placed.
Retain Targets When Changing Actions	When changing an action, target fields are retained as long as the target remains valid. This eliminates you from having to reselect targets if you change actions.
Zoom Level Drop Down	Quickly use a drop-down list to adjust the zoom level when working with a title.
Easy Object Editing	New X and Y coordinates show the width and height of selected objects so you can quickly and precisely edit their size and position.
Rounding Variables	Specify whether you would like to round up or down. Perfect for rounding the scores of tests, combined tests, and surveys involving numbers.
Print Notes	Print all notes included in your course.
Custom SCORM Manifest Identifier	To differentiate between your course manifest name and the course name used within your LMS, the Manifest Identifier now uses the Course ID rather than the MANIFEST1 when publishing to SCORM.
